COVID Update Number 8 - 14 May 2020

Let me start by saying how much we have enjoyed having our wonderful students back! Hearing laughter and play has reminded all of us about why we chose this profession. I am delighted to report we have averaged 88-92% attendance already.

By now you might have heard our Premier's latest announcement about what schools in Western Australia are expected to do from Monday 18 May. From this date all schools are asked to fall in line and in real terms there is nothing unusual or concerning with this announcement.

In summary this is what will happen from next week:

1. All students are expected to attend school, except for those students medically referred to learn from home.
2. This means students are either:
 - at school;
 - have a medical referral to learn from home;
 - recorded as absent if they do not attend; or
 - students who are unwell, should stay home.
3. Students whose parents and carers choose to keep their children at home will be marked as absent and will not be provided a learning program.
4. Students with medical conditions who are not able to attend school will be supported to learn from home and there will be no penalty for non-attendance.
5. Parents/carers and visitors will continue to drop students at the gate unless for a pre-arranged appointment.
6. Parents and carers of students with a medical condition, or a family member/carer in their home with a medical condition, should seek medical advice.
7. If the advice is that a child should not attend school, the parent/carer should notify the school and provide the school with medical evidence such as a medical certificate.
8. Our canteen will still provide takeaway service based on pre-ordering.
9. School assemblies and community events are still NOT permitted.
10. We are still not permitted to commence interschool sport (with other schools) however intra school sport (within our school) is about to commence.
